NONMETALIC MINE OPERATOR'S LICENSES ORDINANCE

This Ordinance shall take effect after its passage and posting as provided by law

Adopted this 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 2012 by the Town Board of the Town of Menomonie, Dunn County, Wisconsin

Purpose: Provide minimum standards for all nonmetallic mining operations, to protect public health and safety, preserve the scenic beauty of the town's landscape and environment, protect ground and surface waters and promote general welfare of the people and communities with the Town of Menomonie
